- Scouts Hall OR Guides Hall in Benalla (depends on which one is available at each weekend)- toilets but no showers. The booking system states Scouts Hall- book in and we will arrange blow up mattresses and let you know which hall it is for your weekend.

There are also various accommodation options in and around Benalla


As in previous years we will supply a free meal in Benalla for Saturday night and will arrange a Sunday lunch and we will have a continuous supply of hot drinks on site.

You will need to bring:

 And if time allows we will continue to revisit recent sites (3-5 year old) and removing old guards and stakes for reuse where possible and formative pruning of the 3-5 year old young trees- which is an activity that has positive and long-term effects on tree health and longevity.
